### **AUDITOR'S REPORT**

To the Board of Directors of the Alberta Party Political Association

I have audited the balance sheet of the Alberta Party Political Association as at December 31, 2009, and the statements of revenues, expenditures, accumulated surplus and changes in cash flows for the year then ended. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Association's management. My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit.

I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial statements are free of any material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit can also include assessing the accounting principles used and estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

In common with many not-for-profit enterprises, the Association derives most of its revenue from donations and fund raising, the completeness of which is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, my verification of revenue was limited to a review of amounts as recorded in the records of the Assocation, and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to donations and other revenues, excess of expenditures over revenues, assets and equity. I have also made some comments in the Notes section of the financial statements

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which might have been determined to be necessary, as per referred to above, these financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Assocation as at December 31, 2009, and the results of its operations and the changes in cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

## 1. PROPERTY TAX PROTEST DONATION

For the past several years, the Alberta Party Political Assocation (Alberta Party) has promoted the concept of a Property Tax Protest, whereby a portion of money donated to the Alberta Party is used to pay the Property Taxes of those specific donors as a protest of (in their opinion) the double taxation of property taxes.

During the reporting period, there were questions raised by the Chief Electoral Office of Alberta as to the propriety of these donations. This resulted in the suspension of the program for the foreseeable future, and a large reduction in the fundraising expenses of the party from the recent past.

#### 2. OTHER REVENUE

Other revenue consisted of the registration costs at the Annual General Meeting and a Silent Auction, performed at the same Annual General Meeting
