In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the "Basis for Qualified Opinion" paragraph, the Leadership Contestant Financial Statement for the candidacy of Jason Kenney, a candidate at the election of a Leader of the United Conservative Party of Alberta held on the 28 day of October, 2017 for the reporting period from July 28, 2017 to December 28, 2017, comprised of the revenue for reporting period, expenses for reporting period, surplus (deficit) for reporting period period and the statement of assets and liabilities for the period ended December 28, 2017 is, in all material respects, in accordance with the Act and in the prescribed form issued by Elections Alberta.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the attached Note 1 to the Statement, which describes the basis of accounting. The Statement is prepared to assist the chief financial officer to meet the requirements of the Elections Finances and Contributions Disclosures Act of Alberta. As a result, the Statement may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the chief financial officer and the chief electoral officer, and should not be used by parties other than the chief financial officer or the chief electoral officer.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements
