(b) by a nomination contestant, to the extent that the real property, goods or services that the expense was incurred for, or that were received as a nonmonetary contribution, are used to directly promote or oppose a nomination contestant during a nomination contest.

(2) For the purposes of this section, the use of goods in a 2nd or subsequent election is a non-monetary contribution.

(3) An election expense referred to in subsection (1) includes an expense incurred for. or a non-monetary contribution in relation to.

(a) the production of advertising or promotional material,

(b) the distribution, broadcast or publication of advertising or promotional material in any media or by any other means during the election period, including by the use of a capital asset,

(c) the payment of remuneration and expenses to or on behalf of a person for the person's services as a chief financial officer or in any other capacity.

(d) securing a meeting space, or

(e) the conduct of election surveys or other surveys or research during an election period.

(4) In this section, "expense incurred" means an expense that is incurred, whether it is paid or unpaid

Election expense limits - registered parties

41.2(1) No registered party and no chief financial officer of a registered party shall incur election expenses in respect of a general election that exceed in the aggregate S2 000 000 as adjusted under section 41.5.

(2) No registered party and no chief financial officer of a registered party shall incur election expenses in respect of a by-election for an electoral division that exceed in the aggregate \$23 000 as adjusted in accordance with section 41.5.

(3) The following expenses are not election expenses for the purposes of subsections (1) and (2):

(a) audit and professional fees necessary for compliance with this Act by the registered party.

(b) expenses incurred to hold a conference or convention of a registered party;

(c) expenses incurred by a registered party to operate a permanent office, including the salaries and wages paid to permanent staff members working in the office during the election period;

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To Gil Poitras, financial agent for the Alberta Advantage Political Party Association, for submission to the Chief Electoral Officer of Alberta in accordance with subsections 43(6) of the *Election Finances and Contributions Disclosure Act* (EFCDA).

REPORT ON THE STATEMENT

We have audited the accompanying Political Party campaign Period Financial Statement ("the Statement") and accompanying applicable schedules for the Alberta Advantage Political Party Association, a registered party in respect of the campaign period ended June 16, 2019 in the province of Alberta.

This Statement has been prepared by the financial agent for the registered party based on the financial reporting provisions of subsection 43(1) of the EFCDA and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Alberta.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the "Basis for Qualified Opinion" paragraph, the Campaign Period Financial Statement is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the reporting provisions of subsection 43(1) of the EFCDA.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of registered parties, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the party's accounting records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenue and expenses.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Statement section of our report. We are independent of the Alberta Advantage Political Party Association in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Statement in Canada and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with those requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

Without modifying our opinion, I draw attention to Note 1 of the Statement, which describes the basis of accounting. The Statement is prepared to assist the financial agent to meet the requirements of the EFCDA. As a result, the Statement may not be suitable for another purpose.
